Angus – sock yarn version

SIZE

One size fits most adults

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

15 cm inches wide, 60
inches long

MATERIALS

[MC] Stahl Fortissima
Mexico Color [75 % Wool,
25% Polyamide; 459
yd/420 m per 100 g
skein]; color: 9072; 1
skein

Yarn Substitution: Any self
striping sock yarn in
fingering weight will do.



1 set(s) US #3/3 mm straight needles

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle

Tape measure

GAUGE

30 sts/42 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

Gauge is not crucial.

PATTERN NOTES

Garter stitch:

Knit all rows

Angus is knitted end to end in one piece.

PATTERN

CO 49 sts

Row 1: knit, place marker in center stitch (stitch # 25)

Row 2: K1, k1fb, knit to stitch before center stitch, k3tog, knit to one stitch before last stitch, k1fb, knit

Row 3: Knit

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until scarf is 140 cm long.

End-row 1: Knit to center stitch, k3tog, knit to end.

End row 2: Knit

Repeat end-row 1 and end-row 2 until there are 3 sts.

K3tog

BO last stitch.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

Cotton sockyarn version

SIZE

One size fits all adults

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

5 inches wide, 67 inches long

MATERIALS

[MC] Regia Cotton Surf Color [75 % Wool, 25% Polyamide; 437 yd/400 m per 100 g skein]; color: 5411;
1 skein



Yarn Substitution: Any self striping cotton sock yarn in fingering weight will do.

1 set(s) US #6/4 mm straight needles

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle

Tape measure

GAUGE

30 sts/42 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

Gauge is not crucial.

PATTERN NOTES

Garter stitch:

Knit all rows

Angus is knitted end to end in one piece.

PATTERN

CO 41 sts

Row 1: knit, place marker in center stitch (stitch # 21)

Row 2: K1, k1fb, Knit to stitch before center stitch, k3tog, knit to one stitch before last stitch, k1fb, knit

Row 3: Knit

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until scarf is 160 cm long.

End-row 1: Knit to center stitch, k3tog, knit to end.

End row 2: Knit

Repeat end-row 1 and end-row 2 until there are 3 sts.

K3tog

BO last stitch.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

Lang Tosca Version

SIZE

One size fits all adults

FINISHED

MEASUREMENTS

14 cm inches wide, 59
inches long

MATERIALS

[MC] Lang Tosca [55
% Wool, 45% Acryl;
100 yd/92 m per 50 g
skein]; color: 0097;
2 skeins



1 set(s) US #10,5/7 mm straight needles

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle

Tape measure

GAUGE

12 sts/17 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

Gauge is not crucial.

PATTERN NOTES

Garter stitch:

Knit all rows

Angus is knitted end to end in one piece.

PATTERN

CO 31 sts

Row 1: knit, place marker in center stitch (stitch # 16)

Row 2: K1, k1fb, Knit to stitch before center stitch, k3tog, knit to one stitch before last stitch, k1fb, knit

Row 3: Knit

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until scarf is 140 cm long.

End-row 1: Knit to center stich, k3tog, knit to end.

End row 2: Knit

Repeat end-row 1 and end-row 2 until there are 3 sts.

K3tog

BO last stitch.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends

Gedifra Fashion Trend Stripe Version

SIZE

One size fits all adults

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

6 inches wide, 59 inches long

MATERIALS

[MC] Gedifra Fashion Trend Stripe [51 % Wool, 49% Acryl; 98 yd/90 m per 50 g skein]; color: 4621; 2 skeins

1 set(s) US #10,5/7 mm

straight needles

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle

Tape measure

GAUGE

16 sts/34 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

Gauge is not crucial.

PATTERN NOTES

Garter stitch:

Knit all rows

Angus is knitted end to end in one piece.



PATTERN

CO 31 sts

Row 1: knit, place marker in center stitch (stitch # 16)

Row 2: K1, k1fb, Knit to stitch before center stitch, k3tog, knit to one stitch before last stitch, k1fb, knit

Row 3: Knit

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until scarf is 130 cm long.

End-row 1: Knit to center stich, k3tog, knit to end.

End row 2: Knit

Repeat end-row 1 and end-row 2 until there are 3 sts.

K3tog

BO last stitch.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends

Knitting abbreviations

Beginner

Projects for first time knitters using basic knit and purl stitches

Easy

Projects using basic stitches, repetitive stitch patterns, simple color changes, and simple shaping and finishing.

Intermediate

Projects with a variety of stitches, such as basic cables and lace, simple intarsia, double-pointed needles and knitting in the round needle techniques, mid-level shaping and finishing.

Experienced

Projects using advanced techniques and stitches, such as short rows, fair isle, more intricate intarsia, cables, lace patterns, and numerous color changes.

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
